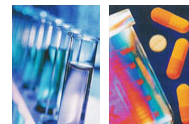
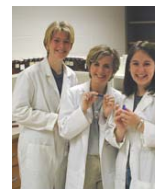

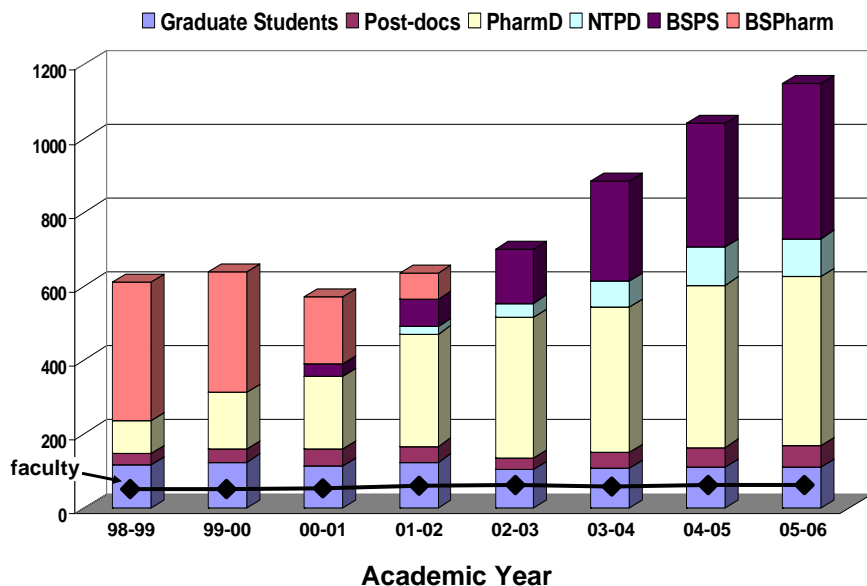

Considered the impact of adding BSPS elective courses and increasing the class size of the PharmD program.

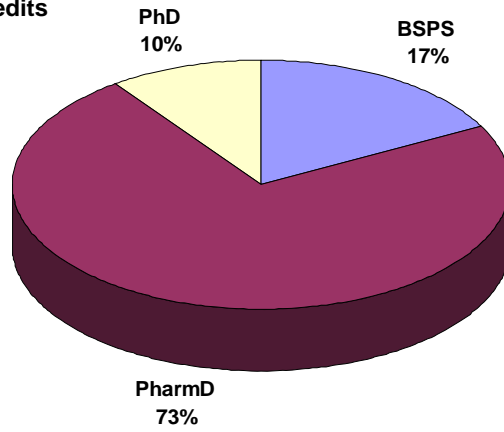
Discussions focused on possible changes on faculty, facilities, finances, the numbers of ELPD and NTPD students in our program, and the graduate placement opportunities.
